Young people take part in virtual and real-world activities to *increase* their motivation and *develop* employability skills to build their *confidence and ability* to enter the workforce. Pathfinder incorporates gamification principles to *engage and motivate* participants to set and *reach their goals*.

The Quest - The program is only two days per week over six weeks.

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Excursions and industry tours will enrich career exploration and informed job search. Sessions are facilitated by a qualified Career Practitioner and Youth Mentor, with support provided throughout the program in collaboration with their Job Active Provider, case manager and/or School.

There are 4 levels of the game:

Explorer, Researcher, Planner and Builder.
